### Varsity Boys Basketball

Lead by Junior Captain, Aidan Cullen 126 lbs (currently 16-2 and ranked #1 in the section), the Spartans have had great showings at the Bethlehem Round Robin, Colonie Duals and Ravena Duals this past weekend. The Spartans core is based with a solid group of underclassmen. 7th grader Kieran Cullen 99lbs (currently 18-2 & ranked 3rd in the section) won the two day Bethlehem tournament going 5-0. 8th grader Kaden Bensen 106 lbs also put forth a solid performance capturing 3rd place. The team only gets stronger as the weights drop with solid performances and key wins from Freshmen Vincent Davis 120 lbs (currently 10-8) and Cole Flannery 160lbs (currently 10-10 & MOW @ Ravena). The team can only grow with their youth and athleticism. Rounding off this solid roster are Eric Heath, Hunter Parker, Melody Sprague, Schuyler Wilson, and Gabe Giovaniello. - A new track facility (including pole vault runway & pit, discuss pit, shot put pit, scoreboard, bathroom facility, storage shed & multipurpose field inside the track)
- New baseball & softball fields (including dug outs, fenced in play areas, scoreboards & batting cages)
- New tennis courts (includes 5 new courts, fenced in area & windscreens)
- Access Road and Event Parking (behind the M/HS) for accessibility
- Replacing the backstops on the existing softball & baseball fields
