Capital Project 2014

Fiber Line & Nurse's Office:

The Board accepted Falcon Data Networks, LLC bid (\$72,650) for the Data Fiber portion of the project at the December 11th board meeting. A draft Owner-Contractor Agreement is being reviewed for signature. Work will begin after January 1st.

Capital Project:

NYSED is expected to complete the review of the Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Life Safety portion of the project by next week. The Civil and Architectural review is complete and comments issued. When the Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Life Safety review comments are received, an addendum will be issued addressing all comments, after which a construction permit will be issued. It is expected that this permit will be ready by the second week in January. Once the permit is issued the district will bid legally ready to advertise for bids.

The project team walked the facilities to confirm replacement of exterior doors and is verify any existing door hardware necessary for replacement.

The project team is preparing final bidding alternates for review by the district.

Stieglitz Snyder Architecture issued the latest set of drawings and specifications to Turner Construction for their Quality Control Review on Friday December 19th 2014. A set of drawings and specifications was also provided to the district.

Stieglitz Snyder Architecture is working with the district to prepare a presentation for a January Workshop dedicated to the Master Plan and the Capital Project. This is scheduled for Saturday January 17th from 9am to 12noon for interested employees and public and will include the architect, Phil Snyder from Stieglitz Snyder Architecture.
