As was shared in the letter you recently received from Cheryl Dudley, our students have met the New York State standards and Greenville Central School District remains a "district in good standing" according to the New York State Education Department. However, the students with disabilities subgroup did not demonstrate adequate yearly progress on state test scores during the past two years in the area of English Language Arts for grades 3-8. Based upon these specific ELA scores, Greenville Middle School has been designated as a School in Need of Improvement – Year 1.

We will continue to work hard to meet the learning needs of all students, and will review and evaluate our programming to target areas for improvement. As part of our plan, we will also offer a Supplemental Education Services (SES) program. If your child qualifies for free or reduced lunch prices, you are encouraged to consider this program.
