Dear Parent / Guardian:

The Greenville Central School District is pleased to offer our students the opportunity to use our computer network in all buildings. The network provides each classroom with access to other classrooms, shared programs, and to the world through the Internet.

In order to comply with Federal legislation and to protect your child, the Board of Education has adopted a policy regarding the use of computers. A copy of the complete policy is available upon request, but the tenets of this policy are listed on the back of this letter. The BOE policy requires that students and their parent or guardian sign an "Acceptable Computer Use" agreement indicating that they have read and understood what is expected of each student.

Young children may be unable to read and understand the expectations regarding computer use. We ask that you discuss these guidelines with them before you sign the form. This agreement is for the protection of your child and purposely violating any of the rules listed could result in your child losing computer network privileges.

Once you are sure your child understands what is expected, please have him/her sign the top of the agreement. Then date and sign at the bottom of the form yourself. Return only the signed agreement (keep this letter as a reference) to your child's teacher (K-5), the middle school office (6-8), or the high school office (9-12 and WSLC). K-5 students are allowed to use computers only under strict supervision and do not have individual computer accounts. Students in grades 6-12 will be given an individual computer account to access the network from any district computer.

Although you may have signed this agreement previously, when a student transitions to a new building (grade 6 and grade 9), we ask that you and your child complete the form again. This will provide an opportunity to remind students of the computer expectations as they move into a new building.

Thank you for your prompt attention in returning this form. Please note that your student will not be granted any computer privileges until we receive the signed form.
