The purpose of this memo is to clarify transportation to and from your child's respective program. Transportation to all programs (Career and Technical, Tech Valley and New Visions) follows the Greenville Central School District calendar. When the Greenville Central School District has a two hour delay, transportation will not be provided to the Tech Valley and New Visions transfer point or morning Career and Technical program at Hudson. When the district is closed, no transportation will be provided.

Tech Valley and New Visions students:

- At 6:30 a.m. the morning Tech Valley/New Visions bus leaves Greenville HS to drop off at Cocksackie HS by 6:40 a.m. to meet the shuttle bus
- Half-day students: At 12:15 p.m. we meet the shuttle bus at Cocksackie Transport to return to Greenville HS
- All day students: at 3:30 p.m. we meet the shuttle bus at Cocksackie Transport to return students to their home
- If your student needs transportation from your home to meet the 6:30 a.m. Tech Valley/New Visions run, please call the Transportation Department – 966-5070 ext 463

Questar III students:

- The morning program runs from 8:15 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. and the afternoon program runs from 11:15 a.m. to 1:45 p.m.
- At 7:20 a.m. the morning bus leaves the HS to the morning program in Hudson
- At 10:30 a.m. the afternoon bus leaves the HS to the afternoon program in Hudson. Your child will be transported back to Greenville to board the regular bus home. Students will be enrolled in classes' periods 1-3 at Greenville HS.
- If your student needs transportation from your home to meet the 7:20 a.m. morning bus, please call the Transportation Department – 966-5070 ext 463

Based on the transportation requests, routes will be planned and you will be notified with the time of pick up for your student.
